Call to Order –Chairman Tedford called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

Verification of the posting of the agenda - Clerical Specialist King verified she posted the agenda per NRS 241 on the 11th day of March 2025 between the hours of 2:30 and 3:30 p.m. at the locations listed on the agenda. Those locations include the Churchill County Administration Building, the Churchill County Web Site, and the State of Nevada Website.

Public Comments –Chairman Tedford asked if there were any public comments. There were no noted comments.

Consideration and possible action re: Review and adoption of agenda –Vice-Chairman Getto motioned to approve the agenda as posted. The motion was seconded by County Manager Barbee and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and possible action re: Review and Adoption of Minutes – County Manager Barbee motioned to approve the minutes of the regular RTC meeting of February 19, 2025, as submitted. The motion was seconded by Vice-Chairman Getto and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and possible action re: March Treasurer's Report – Comptroller Sherry Wideman presented the March Treasurer's report as follows:

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 has a balance of \$1,899,958.65 of which the city has a balance of \$235,332.36, and the county has a balance of \$1,664,626.29. The county has an encumbrance of \$150,000, leaving an available balance of \$1,514,626.29.

The Public Transit Fund 395 has a balance of \$2,422,019.74. The city has a balance of \$29,887.45. The county has a balance of \$2,392,132.29. The county has an encumbrance of \$150,000, leaving an available balance of \$2,242,132.29.

The county's portion of the One-Cent Fund has an available balance of \$216,218.29

Regional Transportation Fund 280 is down by 1.7% from last year for the same 6 months. The Public Transit Fund 395. Sherry stated it is all sketchy right now because the state is changing software, but it is down 13.7 % from the same time last year. Road Supervisor Fowkes asked when the software was going to be fixed. Sherry said the State said March, but whether that was the month of March or when the March numbers were released was not made clear. The One-Cent Fund, which gives us a more accurate relationship with the gas taxes, without diesel, down 1.7% over the same period last year.

The gallonage report shows there were 787,312 gallons of gas, and 717,977 gallons of diesel sold during December.

Sherry asked if there were any questions.

There were none.

Vice-Chairman Getto motioned to approve the March Treasurer's report as submitted. The motion was seconded by County Manager Barbee and carried by a unanimous vote.

City Reports and/or Requests- The City did not have any requests.

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General Discussion of City and/or County Matters- Public Works Director Byrd stated just excited for the weather to warm up so they could continue with their maintenance program. Sierra NV. Construction is our number one project, and we want to get back and continue that.

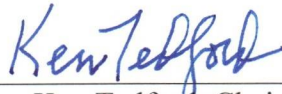
