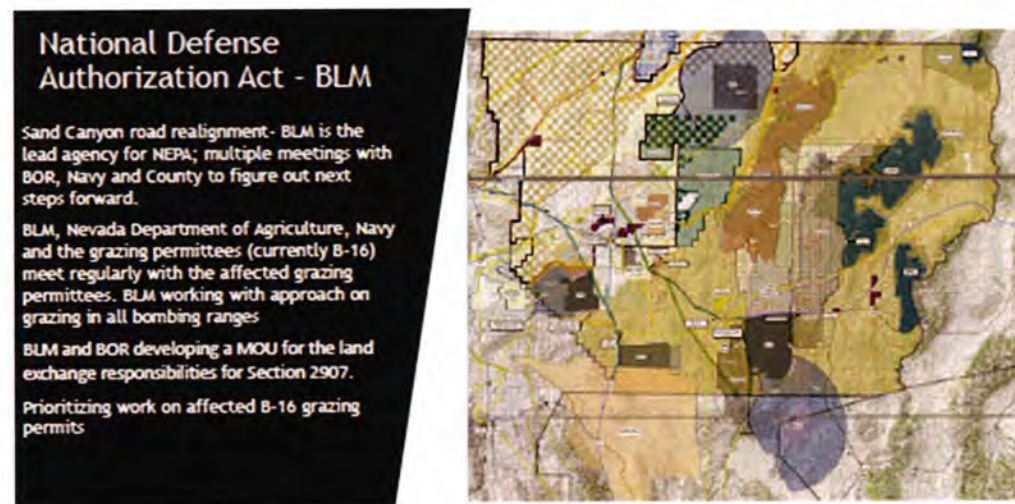

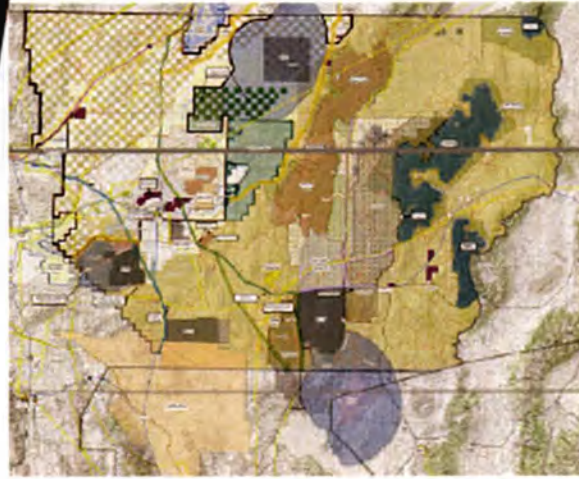


## National Defense Authorization Act - BLM cont.

90% draft of the Churchill County Checkerboard Resolution Implementation Strategy Plan for Section 2908.

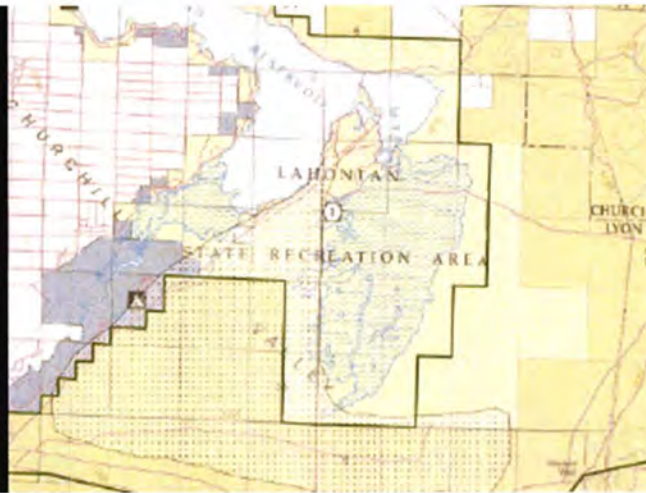
State Route 361- BLM is a cooperating agency. FHWA and NDOT conducting baseline surveys.

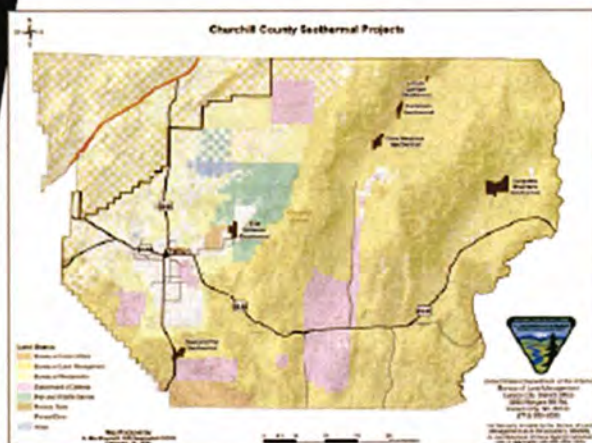
## Wild Horse and Burro

- ▶ Census flights completed March 2025. Raw counted numbers available:
  - ▶ Pilot Table Herd (Mineral County): 579 horses
  - ▶ Marietta Herd (Mineral County): 153 burros, 9 horses
  - ▶ Pine Nut Herd (Douglas, Carson City and Lyon): 222 horses
  - ▶ Garfield Flat Herd (Mineral County): 160 horses
  - ▶ Wassuk Herd (Lyon, Mineral): 94 horses
- ▶ 18 horses adopted at 7/25 event held at Northern NV Correctional Center
- ▶ Prioritizing the Lahontan Herd Management Area (Churchill County) gather EA (Public Comment Period 4/10-5/12)
- ▶ Second priority is the North Complex (Washoe County) horse gather NEPA. North Complex would include the Flanigan, Dogskin Mtn & Granite Peak Herd Management Areas.



## Geothermal Projects

- ▶ Dixie Meadows: A baseline requirements document is near completion with USFWS NASF and BLM, Ormat has participated in the discussions
- ▶ Diamond Flat (exploration) NEPA in progress and working on timeline with NEPA contractor.
  - ▶ BLM is requesting SHPO enter into a Memorandum of Agreement to resolve adverse effects; a Historical Properties Treatment Plan is being developed

- ▶ **Bell Mountain Mine.** Lincoln Resource Group is entering the final design, pre-construction phase for the Bell Mountain Mine. The EA for the project was finalized and Decision Record / FONSI issued March 2020.
- ▶ **Cosmo Dixie Exploration.** Cosmo E&P US., has two Notices for lithium exploration in Dixie Valley. Aquarius, two drill pads and 1,150 feet of constructed road, for a total of 3.47 acres. Sagittarius, one drill pad and 7,060 feet of constructed road, for a total of 4.75 acres.

### **B- Consideration and possible action re: Approval of the Local Public Agency Agreement and the Defense Access Road Agreement for the reconstruction of Lone Tree Road as part of the Navy Modernization Project.**

Churchill County and the Navy have been coordinating to implement the Navy's FRTC Modernization project for several years. One of the requirements to opening the expanded training areas is the reconstruction of Lone Tree Road. Churchill County has offered to coordinate the re-construction project on Lone Tree Road, working with the Navy on the permitting process, designing the road, and overseeing the construction.

As a defense project, the funding for the project is complex and regulation-heavy. Funding will be from the Navy, transmitted to FHWA for review, issued to NDOT for implementation, and, ultimately, transferred to Churchill County and the successful bid awardees. The complex interplay among the various parties has taken significant time to resolve but all parties are satisfied with the current Agreements and looking forward to getting the project underway. The LPA Agreement governs the relationship between NDOT and Churchill County and the DAR Agreement governs the relationship between Churchill County and the Navy over this same project.

#### **A- Bureau of Land Management's notification of its preparation of a categorical exclusion to analyze the potential impacts of a temporary camp to support winter livestock operations on the Dixie Valley grazing allotment known as the Hot Water Cow Camp Project.**

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has prepared a categorical exclusion (CX) to assess the potential impacts of a temporary camp supporting winter livestock operations on the Dixie Valley grazing allotment in Churchill County. Bench Creek Ranch Co. LLC (BCR), the grazing permit holder, requested the camp to monitor cattle and manage water resources. The camp will be located at Hot Water Corral and Well within the Navy's Dixie Valley Training Area. It will be in place from February 25, 2025 through June 15, 2025, covering a 0.1-acre footprint within a 0.6-acre corral area. The project meets categorical exclusion criteria under NEPA, requiring no further environmental documentation, as the site will be restored after use.

The campsite was selected because it is already disturbed by livestock operations, including water use and truck activity, ensuring no new environmental impact. While public land camping is typically limited to 14 days, this authorization extends to approximately 17 weeks. The project meets categorical exclusion criteria under NEPA (516 DM 11.9 J(4)), requiring no further environmental review. There is no opposition to the project. BLM specialists have developed design features to minimize impacts and a review confirmed no significant effects on public health, natural resources, or unique geographic characteristics. The project does not involve controversial or uncertain environmental effects, set a precedent for future actions, or contribute to cumulative environmental impacts. It will not affect historic properties, endangered species, or designated critical habitats. Additionally, it complies with federal, state, and tribal environmental laws, does not restrict access to Indian sacred sites, and will not contribute to the spread of invasive species.

Interested parties may protest the proposed decision in person or in writing to the BLM Stillwater Field Office within 15 days of receiving the decision. Protests must clearly state the reasons for objection. If no protest is filed, the decision becomes final. Appeals and petitions for a stay may be filed within 30 days of the final decision.

This pipeline supports the conversion of the North Valmy Generating Station from coal to natural gas, aligning with NV Energy and Nevada's emission reduction goals. **D- Nevada Division of Environmental Protection's notification of receipt of the Annual 2024 Groundwater Monitoring Report for the Old High School at 690 South Maine Street, Fallon, Nevada and its concurrence with the recommendations contained therein.**

The Nevada Division of Environmental Protection (NDEP) provides notification that the division has reviewed the 2024 Annual Groundwater Monitoring Report for the Old High School site at 690 South Maine Street, Fallon, Nevada. The report, prepared by UES, covers monitoring of 11 wells in May and 6 wells in December 2024. Groundwater depth ranged from 1.6 to 14.19 feet, with flow directed southeast. Light non-aqueous phase liquid (LNAPL), likely residual fuel oil, was found in wells MW-5 and MW-6. Several contaminants, including benzo(a)pyrene, were detected above EPA or Nevada action levels. However, the benzo(a)pyrene result is not considered a new release and is attributed to a lab change. Trend analysis shows stable benzene levels in MW-10 and no trend in MW-4. Continued annual monitoring is recommended and NDEP agrees. The next report is due by January 28, 2026.

**Commissioner Matt Hyde made a motion to levy a special assessment on each permitted water right holder in the Lovelock Valley Groundwater Basin totaling \$143.08, on each permitted water right holder in the Dixie Valley Groundwater Basin totaling \$4,570.55, on each permitted water right holder in the Bradys Hot Springs Area totaling \$5,685.54, and**

**to certify the amounts for the special assessments to be entered on the 2025-2026 Secured and Unsecured Tax Rolls by the County Treasurer. Commissioner Eric Blakey seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.**

**C- Consideration and possible action re: Approval of a Class Specification (Job Description) for a Range Master at a Pay Grade of 42.**

The current duties of Range Master are being performed by Cliff Barnhouse who is classified as an Auxiliary Deputy. Mr. Barnhouse has indicated his wish to retire. Therefore, a replacement is necessary. The duties of an Auxiliary Deputy include the service and enforcement of civil process, as well as the Range Master duties. The Sheriff has indicated that Mr. Barnhouse's replacement will only be responsible for organizing, coordinating, and overseeing the HR 218 qualification program in accordance with NRS 202.3678. This program provides training in the form of a firearms qualification course for qualified law enforcement officers and retired officers to carry a concealed firearm. As the Range Master position does not exist within the county's Job Classifications and, as a result of removing many of the tasks required for the Auxiliary Deputy position, a new job description for Range Master is being requested.

The current Grade for an Auxiliary Deputy is Grade 45 but, as a result of removing many of the tasks, a Grade 42 for the Range Master job description is requested. This is a casual, part-time position with an anticipated schedule of a few hours per month as the qualification testing is only held twice per year.

FISCAL IMPACT: None.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT: Reduction in wages of \$2.16/hour.

FUNDING SOURCE: N/A

ACTION REQUESTED: Accept

Chris Spross, Assistant County Manager/HR Director made the presentation as outlined above.

Chair Getto asked if there was any public comment but there was none.

**Commissioner Eric Blakey made a motion to approve the Class Specification for a Range Master (Casual, Part-time) and assign it to Pay Grade 42. Commissioner Matt Hyde seconded the motion, which carried by unanimous vote.**

**D- Consideration and possible action re: Approval of an employment offer for an exceptional applicant to the District Attorney's Office to be placed at Deputy District Attorney II, Step 7.**

The District Attorney's Office is looking to recruit qualified attorneys to fill an open position in the Criminal Division. The position has been open and posted for approximately three months. The department received three applicants, two of which withdrew their applications prior to the interview. The remaining applicant has significant experience prosecuting criminal cases in another Nevada jurisdiction where they are currently employed. The applicant has deep ties to the community, has family in the Fallon area, and is willing to accept the position. His current remuneration is substantially above the starting position of a Deputy District Attorney II, so the District Attorney's Office is requesting placement at step 7 in the range. While this would be lower than his current salary, it balances with existing long-standing employees and has been

accepted by the applicant with this board's approval.

Churchill County Code 3.32.040 authorizes advanced step placement to: (1) meet a difficult recruiting problem, or (2) employ a person who possesses superior qualifications. Both of these criteria are met in the instance, and we request the Board approve this request.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$15,537.60 salary difference.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT: Difference in annual salary between step 7 and step 1.

FUNDING SOURCE: District Attorney's Office.

**E- Consideration and possible action re: Approval of an Interlocal Agreement between the Nevada Division of Agriculture and Churchill County to collect, test, and submit reports on groundwater samples in Churchill County, not to exceed \$30,000 from April 1, 2025 through March 31, 2030.**

The Nevada Department of Agriculture staff will sample predetermined and approved groundwater wells in Churchill County and provide results for requested tests: pesticides, lithium, arsenic, barium, boron, calcium, copper, hardness, iron, magnesium, manganese, potassium, and silica. The staff will then drop off to and collect all samples from the required laboratories. Reports will be provided to Churchill County within two weeks of sampling; any delays in reporting will be communicated.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$27,960 over 5 years.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT: Fees for staff hours and laboratory testing costs per sample.

FUNDING SOURCE: Water Resources 380-380.

ACTION REQUESTED: Accept

**D- Consideration and possible action re: Approval of Transportation Agreement with the Churchill County School District (CCSD) for the 2025 SUMFUN Program.**

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting permission to renew the Transportation Agreement with the Churchill County School District (CCSD) for buses to be used for transporting campers to designated field trips for the 2025 SUMFUN Program. The term of the Transportation Agreement will be for three (3) months, from June 2, 2025 - August 22, 2025.

The county will pay the district \$2.50 per mile for each mile logged by said buses during the term of this agreement. If there is a change in operating costs for the district, the county agrees to pay the adjusted cost per mile for actual miles logged, provided that the district provides thirty (30) days written notice prior to the effective date of the cost adjustment. In the event the county does not use said buses for its contemplated programs, there will be no charge to the county.

FISCAL IMPACT: The county will pay the district \$2.50 per mile for each mile logged by said buses during the term of this agreement.

**EXPLANATION OF IMPACT:** The agreement provides for a rate of \$2.50 per mile for each mile logged. Fees for the SUMFUM Program are based on the listed terms of \$2.50 per mile, so there is no adverse impact to Churchill County's budget.

**FUNDING SOURCE:** Recreation Budget - 303-5717. Costs are built into the program fees required of participants.

The Claims and Payroll Transmittals were submitted for the board's consideration and approval.

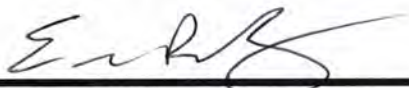

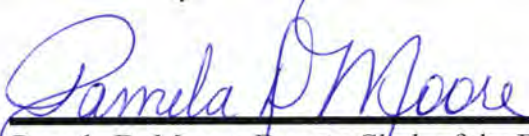
