The Board of County Highway Commissioners met in regular session on the above date at 10:30 A.M. at the Churchill County Commissioners Chambers, 155 N. Taylor St, Fallon, NV, with Chairman Blakey presiding.

Call to order – Chairman Blakey called the meeting to order at 10:30 A.M.

Verification of the agenda posting – Clerical Specialist King verified the agenda was posted per NRS 241 on the 26th day of June 2025 between the hours of 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. at the locations listed on the agenda. Those locations include the Churchill County Road Department, Churchill County Complex Building, Churchill County Web Site, and the State of Nevada Website.

Public Comment – There were none.

Agenda – Vice Chairman Getto motioned to approve the agenda revised with 11-A moved above #7. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyde and carried by a unanimous vote.

Minutes – Commissioner Hyde motioned to approve the minutes of the regular Highway Commission meeting on June 5, 2025 as submitted. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Getto and carried by unanimous vote.

New Business –

- A. Consideration and possible action re: Approval of the County Road Department paying half of the purchase price for the CMS-465-T Message Board in conjunction with the Emergency Management Department. The amount of the Road Departments expenditure will be \$9,410.00 and will be transferred from the Capital Outlay Equipment number 530-530-75100.**

Road Supervisor Fowkes stated the Emergency Management Department received a grant for half of the purchase price of the CMS-465-T Message board. Supervisor Fowkes was approached to contribute the other half of the purchase price. Supervisor Fowkes stated the Road Department would keep the

Message board and do the maintenance on the board; he stated the road department has already used the board. Supervisor Fowkes stated that the county uses message boards for many projects such as Graduations etc. The funds from the Road Department would come out of the Capital Outlay Equipment fund 530-530-75100.

Incoming County Manager Spross clarified that the grant would have only be approved if the County supplied the second half of the purchase price.

Commissioner Hyde motioned to Approve the purchase of the CMS-465-T Message Board. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Getto and carried by unanimous vote.

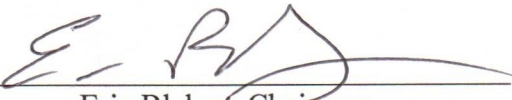
Department Reports-

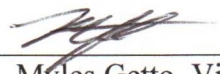
Monthly departmental report - Road Supervisor Gary Fowkes reported on Road Department matters, accomplishments, and projects (**A complete report is attached to the original packet**).
