Call to Order –Chairman Tedford called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

Verification of the posting of the agenda - Clerical Specialist Bobbie King verified she posted the agenda per NRS 241 on the 10th day of September 2025 between the hours of 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. at the locations listed on the agenda. Those locations include the Churchill County Administration Building, the Churchill County Web Site, and the State of Nevada Website.

Public Comments –Chairman Tedford asked if there were any public comments. There were no noted comments.

Consideration and possible action re: Review and adoption of agenda –Chief of Staff Erickson motioned to approve the agenda as posted. The motion was seconded County Manager Spross and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and possible action re: Review and Adoption of Minutes – County Manager Spross motioned to approve the minutes of the regular RTC meeting of August 20, 2025, as submitted. The motion was seconded by Chief of Staff Erickson and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and possible action re: August Treasurer's Report – Comptroller Sherry Wideman presented the September Treasurer's report as follows:

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 has a balance of \$1,847,686.84 of which the city has a balance of \$136,607.63, and the county has a balance of \$1,711,079.21. The county has an encumbrance of \$150,000 leaving an available balance of \$1,621,082.39.

The Public Transit Fund 395 has a balance of \$2,575,261.34. The city has a balance of \$59,136.87. The county has a balance of \$2,516,124.47. The county has an encumbrance of \$150,000, leaving an available balance of \$2,520,539.98.

The county's portion of the One-Cent Fund has an available balance of \$192,719.83

Regional Transportation Fund 280 this is the twelve-month total and is down by 5.3% from the **previous** year. The Public Transit Fund 395 is 4.5 % increase from 2024, but not really comparable to the previous year because they are calculating it differently what used to be calculated in July has been rolled into June. The One-Cent Fund, which gives us a more accurate relationship with the gas taxes, without diesel, was down 4.6% from the previous year.

The gallonage report shows there were 783,888 gallons of gas, and 638.654 gallons of diesel sold during June.

Chief of Staff Erickson motioned to approve the July Treasurer's report as submitted. The motion was seconded by County Manager Spross and carried by a unanimous vote.

City Reports and/or Requests-The City did not have any requests.

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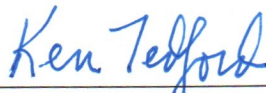
General Discussion of City and/or County Matters- Public works director Byrd stated they received notice from NDOT to proceed with the signal light on US 50 at Sherman and Williams the city has a 90-day window to get the bid out and get the project started. The estimate is around a million dollars.
