Call to order – Chairman Blakey called the meeting to order at 10:30 A.M.

Verification of the agenda posting – Clerical Specialist King verified the agenda was posted per NRS 241 on the 28th day of August 2025 between the hours of 2:00 and 3:00 p.m. at the locations listed on the agenda. Those locations include the Churchill County Road Department, Churchill County Complex Building, Churchill County Web Site, and the State of Nevada Website. Public Comment – Clint & Christine Newmyer 4110 Portuguese Ln. Mr. Newmyer stated we are here to discuss the weeds and the issues they are causing on Portuguese Ln. He states he had sent emails in the past and spoken with the past county manager, this morning he sent an email to the road department and Gary Fowkes the Road Supervisor returned his call. Supervisor Fowkes explained to Mr. Newmyer that he could call anytime when there was a problem, and they would be added to the schedule. Mr. Newmyer feels the workers should report to Supervisor Fowkes when there is a problem. Christine Newmyer stated Boundary Ln. and Portuguese are basically parallel if you drive north bound either road you can make a right or left onto Souza it is basically a loop Boundary between Souza and Reservation Rd., she states there are only two people that live there and it is groomed every six weeks. She states that the employees turn in front and sometimes use their property to turn around. She is questioning why the workers aren't reporting it to the supervisor so action can be taken, work needing to be done can be added to the schedule.

Chairman Blakey thanked them both for their comments and explained we can take no action on public comment, but their comments have been heard and will be part of public record.

Agenda – Vice Chairman Getto motioned to approve the agenda as posted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Hyde and carried by a unanimous vote.

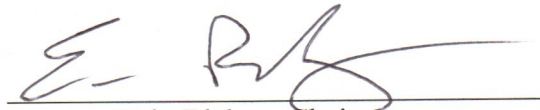
Department Reports-
