Call to Order –Chairman Tedford called the meeting to order at 11:01 a.m.

Verification of the posting of the agenda - Recording Secretary Bobbie King verified that the agenda was posted in accordance with NRS 241 on March 11, 2026, between the hours of 10:00 and 11:00 a.m., at the locations listed on the agenda, including the Churchill County Administration Building, the Churchill County website, and the State of Nevada website.

Public Comments – Chairman Tedford requested public comment. No comments were received.

Consideration and Possible Action: Review and Adoption of Agenda – County Manager, Chris Spross moved to approve the agenda as posted. The motion was then seconded by Vice-Chairman Myles Getto and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and Possible Action: Review and Adoption of Minutes – Vice-Chairman, Myles Getto moved to approve the minutes of the regular RTC meeting of February 18, 2026, as submitted. The motion was then seconded by Chief of Staff, Bob Erickson, and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and Possible Action: March Treasurer's Report – Comptroller Sherry Wideman presented the March Treasurer's Report as follows:

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 has a total balance of \$2,345,575.29. Of that total, the City's balance is \$440,099.37 and the County's balance is \$1,905,475.92. The County has an encumbrance of \$150,000.00, leaving an available total fund balance of \$2,195,575.29.

The Public Transit Fund 395 has a total balance of \$3,161,763.32. Of that total, the City's balance is \$217,336.68 and the County's balance is \$2,944,426.64. The County has an encumbrance of \$977,857.62, leaving an available total fund balance of \$2,183,905.70.

The County's portion of the One-Cent Fund has an available balance of \$177,390.28.

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 shows a decrease of 6.20% compared to the same five-month period in the prior year. The Public Transit Fund 395 reflects an increase of 28.31% over that same period last year. Comptroller Sherry Wideman reminded the Board that the data is being pulled differently; therefore, the prior year comparison is not an apples-to-apples comparison.

The One-Cent Fund, which more accurately reflects gas tax revenue excluding diesel, shows a decrease of 5.68% compared to the prior year period.

The gallonage report indicates that 755,238 gallons of gasoline and 669,776 gallons of diesel were sold during December 2025.

Vice Chairman, Myles Getto moved to approve the March Treasurer's Report as submitted. The motion was then seconded by County Manager, Chris Spross, and carried by a unanimous vote.

City Reports and/or Requests- Public Works Director Brian Byrd stated that there were no reports or requests from the city at this time.

County Reports and/or Requests- Road Supervisor Gary Fowkes stated that there were no reports or requests from the County at this time.

General Discussion of City and/or County Matters- Neither the City nor the County had any matters to discuss.

Future Agenda Items – There were no future agenda items.

Public Comments – Chairman Tedford requested public comment. No comments were received.

Adjournment – With no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Ken Tedford declared the meeting adjourned at 11:06 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on **April 15, 2026**, at the Churchill County Administrative Complex, 155 N. Taylor Street, Room 194, Fallon, NV 89406.
