Call to Order – Vice-Chairman Tedford called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m.

Verification of the posting of the agenda - Recording Secretary Bobbie King verified that the agenda was posted in accordance with NRS 241 on June 10, 2026, between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m., at the locations listed on the agenda, including the Churchill County Administration Building, the Churchill County website, and the State of Nevada website.

Public Comments – Vice-Chairman Tedford requested public comment. No comments were received.

Consideration and Possible Action: Review and Adoption of Minutes – County Manager Interim, Joe Sanford moved to approve the minutes of the regular RTC meeting of May 20, 2026, as submitted. The motion was then seconded by Chief of Staff, Bob Erickson, and carried by a unanimous vote.

Consideration and Possible Action: June Treasurer's Report – Comptroller Sherry Wideman presented the June Treasurer's Report as follows:

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 has a total balance of \$2,521,40.20. Of that total, the City's balance is \$567,226.10 and the County's balance is \$1,954,181.10. The County has an encumbrance of \$150,000.00, leaving an available total fund balance of \$2,371,407.20.

The Public Transit Fund 395 has a total balance of \$3,319,607.08. Of that total, the City's balance is \$273,636.11 and the County's balance is \$3,045,970.97. The County has an encumbrance of \$977,857.62, leaving an available total fund balance of \$2,341,749.46.

The County's portion of the One-Cent Fund has an available balance of \$192,196.46.

The Regional Transportation Fund 280 shows a decrease of 3.10% compared to the same period in the prior year. The Public Transit Fund 395 reflects an increase of 20.59% over the same period last year.

The One-Cent Fund, which provides a clearer picture of gasoline tax revenue excluding diesel, shows a decrease of 2.68% compared to the prior year.

The gallonage report indicates that 850,878 gallons of gasoline and 718,132 gallons of diesel were sold during March 2026.

County Manager Interim, Joe Stanford, moved to approve the June Treasurer's Report as submitted. The motion was then seconded by Chief of Staff, Bob Erickson, and carried by a unanimous vote.

City Reports and/or Requests- Public Works Director Brian Byrd stated that there were no reports or requests from the city at this time.

County Reports and/or Requests-

A. Consideration and Possible Action re: Transfer of funds to the Churchill County Road Department in the amount of \$827,857.62 to purchase three ten-wheel dump trucks/snowplows.

Recording Secretary Bobbie King advised that the Churchill County Road Department is requesting a transfer of funds in the amount of \$827,857.62 to purchase three ten-wheel dump trucks/snowplows. The transfer is to come from Public Transit fund 395. Churchill County Road Department is requesting transferring the encumbered amount of \$827,857.62 which was approved by the board at the November 12, 2025, meeting.

Chief of Staff, Bob Erickson moved to approve the transfer of funds to the Churchill County Road Department in the amount of \$827,857.62 to purchase three ten-wheel dump trucks/snowplows. The transfer is to come from the Public Transit fund 395. Churchill County Road Department is requesting transferring the encumbered amount of \$827,857.62 in which was approved by the board at the November 12, 2025, meeting. The motion was seconded by County Manager Interim, Joe Sanford and carried by a unanimous vote.

General Discussion of City and/or County Matters- Public Works Director Brian Byrd stated the City had no updates. Road Supervisor Gary Fowkes asked Public Works Director Brian Byrd when the city would be completing its slurry seal projects. Public Works Director Brian Byrd stated the projects were scheduled for the fall. Road Supervisor Gary Fowkes requested that Public Works Director Brian Byrd contact him when the projects begin.

Future Agenda Items – There were no future agenda items.

Public Comments – Vice-Chairman Tedford requested public comment. No comments were received.

Adjournment – With no further business to come before the Board, Vice-Chairman Ken Tedford declared the meeting adjourned at 11:09 a.m. The next meeting is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on **August 19, 2026**, at the Churchill County Administrative Complex, 155 N.
