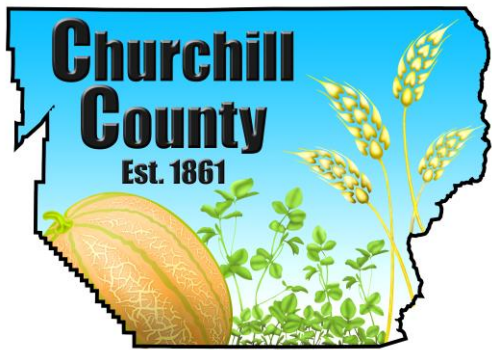

- V. Any statement made by a member of the Cemetery Board during the public meeting is absolutely privileged.**

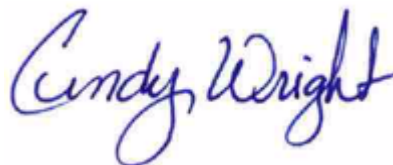
