Updates – Road Supervisor Gary Fowkes said he was speaking to Paul Harmon from the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT). Mr. Harmon informed him NDOT was purchasing a new chip spreader, which roughly cost about \$320,000. He advised NDOT would be selling their old chip spreader, which Gary said he purchased for \$1,500.00. It has an adjustable header on it, and although it is older, the Road Department only chip seals approximately 10 miles per year.

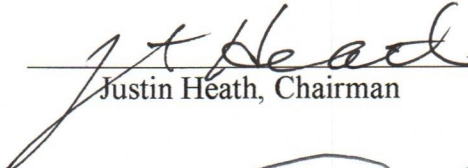
Future Agenda Items – There were no future agenda items.

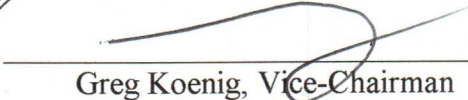
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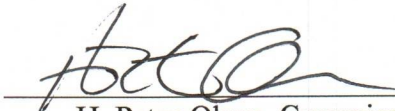
