Dave Greeley wants to change his type of license from a Special Events Liquor License to a Quarterly Mobile On-Premises Liquor License for his business called Silver Sage Promotions, LLC. Mr. Greeley is requesting a perpetual Quarterly Mobile On-Premises.

Sheriff Richard Hickox has conducted an investigation to determine if Mr. Greeley is eligible to receive a liquor license and has found no reason that he cannot be issued the liquor license. The party already holds a Special Event Liquor License but wants to change to a Quarterly Mobile On-Premises Liquor License. Mr. Greeley's associated work permit is current.

Sheriff Richard Hickox has conducted an investigation to determine if Mr. and Mrs. Picotte are eligible to receive a liquor license to operate the facility and has found no reason that they cannot be issued the liquor license. The parties already hold a liquor license for The Grid and this will be a second business location. Their associated work permits are current.

EXPLANATION OF IMPACT: A liquor license fee of \$90 per quarter is paid to help offset the costs of administering the liquor license.

Chairman Scharmann asked if there was any public comment but there was none.

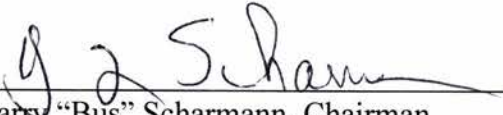
