A- Consideration and possible action re: Canvass of the 2024 Churchill County Official Presidential Preference Primary held on February 6, 2024.

As required by N.R.S. 293.387(1), a Canvass of the Votes of the Official Churchill County Presidential Preference Primary Election held on February 6, 2024 must be completed by the Churchill County Board of Commissioners within 6 working days following the election. In making the Canvass, the board shall:

- A. Note separately any clerical errors discovered; and
- B. Take account of the changes resulting from the discovery so that the results declared

represents the true vote cast.

The County Clerk shall, as soon as the result is declared, enter upon the records of the board an Abstract of the result, which must contain the number of votes cast for each candidate. The board, after making the Abstract, shall cause the County Clerk to certify the Abstract and, by an order made and entered into the Minutes of the proceedings, to make:

- A. A copy of the certified Abstract; and
- B. A mechanized report of the Abstract in compliance with regulations adopted by the Secretary of State and transmit them to the Secretary of State not more than 10 working days after the election.

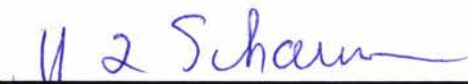

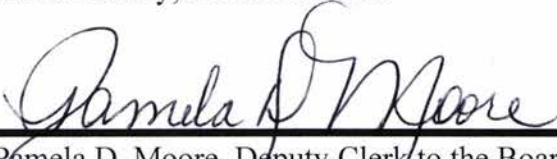
